ENERGY.

As a company we are aware of the impact to transport because of location, but where possible we will endeavour to use public transport and when travelling to sites.

Through co-ordinated route planning and delivery schedules this company continues to realise the dual benefits of reduced fuel consumption and lower exhaust emissions.

PURCHASING AND PROCUREMENT.

Continue the supply of environmentally friendly cleaning products such as paper hand towels, hand wash, and toilet cleaner.
